GAME HIGHLIGHTS

- After the Stars completed comebacks in the previous two meetings against the Storm, it was the Seattle who battled back in an effort to win on the road in the final seconds, but fell short 70-77.
- Seattle fell to San Antonio after shooting for 32.9% while San Antonio connected on 45.3% from the floor.
- The Storm falls to 4-7 on the season, while the Stars gained their second win and now sit at 2-7.

KEY STAT OF THE GAME

- Breanna Stewart tallied her fifth career double-double after leading the team in points (19) and rebounds (15).

STORM HIGHLIGHTS

- Breanna Stewart grabbed 15 rebounds and after tonight leads the league in rebounds with 10.1 per game, ahead of Tina Charles of the New York Liberty who averages 9.7 boards.
- Seattle tied its most field goals attempted on the season with 70.
- Jewell Loyd scored 17 points and grabbed 5 rebounds on 32 minutes of action.
- Sue Bird drained her first and only three-pointer with 5:05 to play in the game, cutting the Seattle deficit to 68-63. Bird has hit a three-pointer in eight-consecutive games and has connected from deep in nine of the Storm's 11 games this season.
- Alysha Clark (14 points tonight), Jewell Loyd (17 points tonight), Sue Bird (7 points tonight) and Breanna Stewart (19 points tonight) are the remaining Seattle players who have scored in every game they have played in 2016.
