

**Indiana Fever vs. Seattle Storm**  
**Regular Season Game #6**  
**Home Game #4**  
**Wednesday, June 1, 2016**

**KEY STAT:**

- The Fever limited the Storm to only one offensive rebound while allowing zero second-chance points. The one offensive rebound ties the franchise record for the fewest offensive rebounds allowed in a game.

**KEY RUN:**

- After Seattle cut the lead to three points late in the second quarter, Indiana closed the first half on a 13-3 run over the final 3:21 of the second quarter to lead 51-38 entering halftime.

**INDIANA NOTES:**

- The Fever led by as many as 22 points (72-50, 1:04 remaining in the third quarter) in tonight's game. Entering tonight, Indiana had not led by more than 15 points in any game this season.
- Indiana forced a season-high 20 turnovers while outscoring the Storm, 19-12, in second-chance points.
- Lynetta Kizer led the Fever as she set a new career high with 20 points on 8-for-13 shooting in 22 minutes off the bench.
- Tiffany Mitchell set a new season high with 19 points as she shot 5-for-13 from the field and a perfect 7-for-7 from the foul line.
- Marissa Coleman scored in double figures for the third time this season as she finished with 11 points to go with a season-high seven rebounds.

**SEATTLE NOTES:**

- Breanna Stewart led the Storm with 22 points and eight rebounds. She has now scored 20 or more points three times through the first six games of her WNBA career.
- Sue Bird finished with 14 points and a game-high six assists.
- Storm guard and Notre Dame product Jewell Loyd added 11 points and four rebounds in 30 minutes.
