Quoting Seattle Head Coach Jenny Boucek

“(On Jewell Loyd’s big plays down the stretch) It was hectic, a hectic fourth quarter. It’s really tough to win on the road. Try to put yourself in position and you hope things go your way. The other night against Connecticut they didn’t and tonight they did..(On the team’s successful first and third quarters) Overall, I thought we were pretty focused on our game plan and we just stuck with it and so I think that helped us.
