INDIANA FEVER HEAD COACH **STEPHANIE WHITE**

(On the game)

"Well, it wasn't pretty. I was proud of our resilience and really fighting through some things to be able to come away with a win. I thought our defense got a little more active in the second half and our offense got a little more fluid. Any time our defense really generates offense for us, it gives us some confidence. I love the way we shared the ball and had great balance on the offensive end of the floor. We tried to take it up a notch in the second half and we got up one notch, not much more than that. But at the same time, we found ways and that's what it's about – our growth. At the end of the day, when it's not going as well as we'd like, to find ways to win and we that."

(On going 2-1 on this road trip)

"More than anything, for us, it's being able to put together a couple games back to back now. Even though the game wasn't pretty, the way that we played, really, over the last nine quarters has been more like the way that we want to play overall. That's the most encouraging thing to me. We're starting to really figure out who we are and how we need to play in order to give ourselves a chance to be successful."

FEVER FORWARD **SHENISE JOHNSON**

(On the game)

"I thought we moved the ball very well tonight. We shared the ball extremely well. We always talk about making three or four passes before we take our shots and I thought it showed through tonight."

(On enduring Seattle's first-half run)

"Seattle is a good, young team. They're never out of it and their confidence is always high so we had to make sure we were doing what we're supposed to do on our end. We tried to make sure we locked in on our defensive schemes because we were missing rotations on Breanna Stewart and Jewell Loyd and letting them get offensive rebounds. We tried to make sure we stayed locked in."

(On getting a career high in points)

"The only thing that matters is a win. Like I said, the ball was moving extremely well tonight and I think we had six people in double figures so when the ball is moving, everybody is allowed to get touches."

FEVER FORWARD **TAMIKA CATCHINGS**

(On the game)

"I really liked our energy, especially in the second half. We didn't really have a good second quarter, but we came out after halftime and really executed offensively and defensively – moving the ball, knocking down shots and our posts were battling down low. I thought we did a much better job locking up on (Stewart) and making other people try to score (in the second half)."

(On the team's balance and strong bench play)

"That's what we have to do – we're at our best when we move the ball. Nobody really cares about who gets the most points. It's just a matter of passing the ball and moving it side to side, then getting the right shots. When we do that, I find that we make a lot of our shots – wide open shots instead of contested shots. As a team, we do a really good job and our bench has been great coming in and giving us great minutes and executing."
