CHICAGO SKY vs. SEATTLE STORM

GAME HIGHLIGHTS

- Chicago dominated the first half, scoring 56 points to Seattle's 32. The roles were swapped during the second half when Seattle scored 56 points to Chicago's 35.
- Seattle marked a season-high eight blocks on the night (7 vs. Dallas 6/30), rookie Breanna Stewart posted a season-high five of those (4, 3 times).

KEY STAT OF THE GAME: THREE-POINT BATTLE

- Elena Delle Donne and Sue Bird combined for a total of 59 points on 77.8 percent from beyond the three-point arc.

STORM HIGHLIGHTS

- Breanna Stewart scored 22 points on 8-of-17 shooting. Tonight was her 11th-consecutive game hitting double-digits.
- Sue Bird scored 24 points on 9-of-16 shooting and 4-of-6 from the three-point arc, tying her season-high (at Connecticut 6/10/16).
- Seattle managed to outscore Chicago 14-6 in fastbreak points, going 7-of-7, while Chicago went only 2-of-2.
- The Storm outscored the Sky in both the third and fourth quarters, dropping 56 points in the second half. Seattle had its best fourth quarter scoring this season, shooting 12-of-17 for 70.6 percent.
- Seattle marked a season-high eight blocks on the night (7 vs. Dallas 6/30), rookie Breanna Stewart posted a season-high five of those (4, 3 times).
- Krystal Thomas recorded a season-high seven points off the bench, going 3-of-3 from the floor and grabbed a season-high six rebounds.
- Kaleena Mosqueda-Lewis tallied 12 points for the second game in a row, which ties her season-high (Washington, 7/15). She shot 55.5 percent from the floor compared to 36.4 percent in her previous showing.

SKY HIGHLIGHTS

- Chicago jumped out to a 36-14 lead after the first quarter behind 11 points from Elena Delle Donne. Courtney Vandersloot added 9 points in the opening frame.
- At the break, Chicago led 56-32. The 56 points are the most the Storm has given up in the first half in 2016.
- The Sky outrebounded the Storm 41-28 and outscored Seattle in second chance points 21-7.
- Elena Delle Donne recorded her third double-double on the season after scoring 35 points and grabbing 11 rebounds. This is her 18th consecutive game scoring in double-digits.

NEXT GAME: Seattle hosts San Antonio to close out its homestand on Wednesday, July 20 at noon.
