SEATTLE STORM at ATLANTA DREAM

GAME HIGHLIGHTS

- Breanna Stewart scored 11 points and pulled down 11 rebounds, recording her sixth double-double in her career. It is the seventh game she has recorded double-digit rebounds.
- Sue Bird dished out 6 assists, the eighth time in 2016 that she has recorded six or more dimes in a single game.
- The Storm held the Dream to only one three-point field goal, which is an opponent season-low. Atlanta connected on 1-of-10 from distance tonight.
- After scoring 28 points in the first half, Seattle scored 26 in the third quarter alone to take a 54-52 lead into the fourth quarter. The team shot 9-of-19 (47.4%) in that frame.

KEY STAT OF THE GAME

- Atlanta opened the fourth quarter on a 7-0 outburst in 1:36, taking a 59-54 lead with 8:34 to play. Jenna O'Hea ended the Dream's run with a free-throw line jumper.

STORM HIGHLIGHTS

- Jewell Loyd was held scoreless in the first half, the first time in 2016 that she has not scored in the opening half. She erupted in the third quarter for 13 points on 4-of-8 shooting, and ended her evening with 13 points.
- Despite scoring 13 points in the third quarter and going scoreless in the first, second and fourth frames, Jewell Loyd led Seattle in scoring.
- Seattle scored 13 points in the first quarter, including 6 in the last 2:30 of the opening frame. Their output narrowly topped the team's lowest first quarter output in 2016 (12, @ Phoenix, 5/20/16).
- Breanna Stewart scored 11 points and pulled down 11 rebounds, recording her sixth double-double in her career. It is the seventh game she has recorded double-digit rebounds.
- After scoring 28 points in the first half, Seattle scored 26 in the third quarter alone to take a 54-52 lead into the fourth quarter. The team shot 9-of-19 (47.4%) in that frame.
- Seattle ended the game with 64 points, the team's lowest point total in 2016. (66, @ Los Angeles, 5/15/16)
- Sue Bird dished out 6 assists, the eighth time in 2016 that she has recorded six or more dimes in a single game.
- Sue Bird's 9 points tonight are the third-lowest total the guard has scored in a single game in 2016. Tonight marks the second-straight game she's scored 9 points, as she did the same vs. Dallas on 6/30/16.
- Seattle went 10-of-10 from the foul line, the first time this season the team has collectively shot 100%. Tonight marks the seventh time the Storm has shot 85.0% or greater from the stripe.
- Seattle's bench tallied 20 points, outscoring Atlanta's bench 20-14. Tonight was the third time this season the Storm outscored their opponent's bench.
- The Storm held the Dream to only one three-point field goal, which is an opponent season-low. Atlanta connected on 1-of-10 from distance tonight.
