On mindset coming into today...

“We had a clear understanding of what they liked to do and what they are good at and we just did not get it done.”

On Dream getting shots they wanted in 4th quarter...

“We did not do a very good job of protecting the paint. We did not rebound well. They got very aggressive and we did not resist that.”
