

Storm Head Coach Jenny Boucek:

(On Breanna Stewart's impact...)

“She’s got a very, very passionate fire burning within her, and it doesn’t express itself as it might in some other players externally, but she is as competitive as anybody I’ve ever coached. She can do a little bit of everything. She just wants to win, and she’s not in any way self-centered in that way where it has to be scoring or it has to be numbers or this and that. She literally will do whatever, and she makes winning all over the floor, so we’re excited to grow with her.”

“We don’t even think about it. Honestly, I haven’t even thought about that. That’s more for you guys than us. We just try to stay in the moment, try to get better every game, so we analyze win or lose in the same fashion. We just try to stay the course.”

Storm Forward Breanna Stewart:

“She’s always a pest on the court. You guys should know that better than me, but that’s what she does. She’s able to get all over the place. She’s so fast. She uses her speed and quickness like no other and made it difficult to really contain.”

“I think that Jenny hit the nail on the head. We know that there’s more that we have left in the tank, and the season’s not even close to being over, and we need to just you know get some good wins under our belt and continue.
