

GAME NOTES

- Swin Cash was honored with a retirement ceremony postgame. WNBA President Lisa Borders, New York Liberty President Isiah Thomas, Liberty head coach Bill Laimbeer, Tina Thompson, Tanisha Wright, Tina Charles, Sue Bird, and Swin Cash spoke during the ceremony.
- Sugar Rodgers hit four 3-pointers to set a new Liberty single-season record with 82 this year, which leads the WNBA.
- The Liberty has secured the No. 3 seed for the WNBA playoffs with tonight's loss combined with Chicago's loss at Washington.
- The Liberty is now 4-9 when trailing after the first quarter
- Tina Charles finished with 22 points, nine rebounds and seven assists, topping 20 points for the 16th time this season
- Seattle shot 54.8 percent from the field – its third-highest percentage of the year – and reached 100 points for the first time since 2012.
- Not only was it Seattle's first win at New York since 2010, but the victory also snapped an eight-game losing streak against the Liberty that dated back to 2012.
- Jewell Loyd had a game-high 25 points on 9-of-14 shooting, while Breanna Stewart finished with 23 points, nine rebounds and three blocks.
- Crystal Langhorne returned to the starting lineup after missing one game due to injury, and she added a season-high 21 points on 10-of-12 shooting and nine boards.
