Postgame Notes

- Tamera Young scored a new season high in tonight's game with 24 points. Her previous record this season was 15 points, which she recorded in two games earlier in the season. Overall, she finished with 24 points, four rebounds and four assists. This was Young's first 20-plus point game in the 2016 season, and she finished 10-of-14 shots.
- Young's 24 points was also her Sky career high. Her previous high while in a Sky uniform was 20, which was recorded against Connecticut on June 23, 2011.
- Several Sky players reached career milestones against the Storm tonight: Young grabbed her 1,000th-career rebound in the first quarter of the game; Allie Quigley recorded her 200th rebound of her career late in the third quarter. Quigley finished the game with six points and two rebounds; Elena Delle Donne made her 700th career field goal at the 3:26 mark in the second quarter. She finished tonight's game with 22 points, which is her 12th game scoring 20 or more points.
- In the first half with her seventh point, Delle Donne passed Candice Dupree and is now third in franchise history for all-time scoring. Delle Donne now has 2,115 total points in a Sky uniform.
- Jessica Breland recorded her second game with 10 rebounds.

- She grabbed 10 rebounds earlier in the season against Atlanta on May 22. Breland finished the game with four points and 10 rebounds, eight of which were defensive.
- In addition to Young and Delle Donne's double-digit performances, Cappie Pondexter added 13 points and Courtney Vandersloot contributed 11. The Sky also dominated the paint with 42 points to Seattle's 24. Fast break points were also in Chicago's favor with 27 points to the Storm's 11.
 - Breanna Stewart and Jewell Loyd both recorded double-doubles for Seattle. Stewart finished with 13 points and 10 rebounds, and Loyd with 23 points and 10 rebounds. Veteran guard Sue Bird also added 15 points for the Storm.
 - Alysha Clark made her 300th field goal in tonight's matchup, tallying five points in the Storm's loss.
 - Breanna Stewart also reached a milestone tonight. With her seventh point of the game, she eclipsed 500 career WNBA points. She became the eighth-youngest (22 years, 6 days) and sixth-fastest (28 games) to achieve this feat.
 - In her two years in the WNBA, Loyd (a native of Lincolnwood, Ill.) has averaged 18.3 points and 6.0 rebounds against Chicago. Seattle will face Chicago for the final time this season on September 18, 2016.
 - Seattle's Ramu Tokashiki tied her season high of 15 points and tallied seven rebounds off the bench.
