Postgame Notes

- The Mystics snapped a two game winning streak, losing 81-76 to the visiting Seattle Storm
- All five Mystics starters scored in double figures led by forward Emma Meesseman who scored 15 points, connecting on 7-of-14 from the field and one from the free throw line. Mystics forward Tierra Ruffin-Pratt added 13 points, shooting 5-of-9 from the field, including 2-of-3 from three-point range and one from the free throw line
- Mystics center Stefanie Dolson and guard Natasha Cloud added 12 points apiece while guard Tayler Hill contributed 11 points in the Mystics effort
- The game remained close throughout with eight lead changes and seven ties in the contest
- The Storm outshot the Mystics in all three categories and outrebounded the Mystics 36-26
- The Storm were led by veteran guard Sue Bird and rookie forward Breanna Stewart who scored a game-high 17 points apiece. Bird was one assist shy of what would have been her 22nd career double-double. Bird shot 6-of-11 from the field, including 3-of-5 from three-point and range and connected on two from the free throw line. Stewart posted a double-double, pulling down 10 rebounds. Stewart connected on 6-of-13 from the field, also shooting 3-of-5 from three-point range and connecting on two from the free throw line.
